General Terms and Conditions

1. **Inviting Annual Rate Contract for disposal of Hazardous chemical waste from various laboratories on 'As is where is basis' from ACTREC, Kharghar for the period of two years from 1st November 2021 to 31st October 2023. (Extendable for one year subject to satisfactory performance.)**
2. The bids are invited for the whole and no bid would be accepted for any part of the same. **The list items are enclosed in tender documents.**
3. The tender shall be valid for 90 days from the date of opening of the tender.
4. Bidders are requested to read and understand the terms and conditions of the tender mentioned in the foregoing paragraphs before submitting the quotation, as no violation of the aforesaid terms and conditions shall be permitted once the quotation is accepted by this office. Tender acceptance Letter is annexed with tender notice.
5. The rates should be quoted in figures & words in Indian Rupees **Annexure- 1**. The quoted rates will be basic rates only over and above this **Goods and Services Tax will be extra as applicable** under rules. **In case the rates are not quoted in the Annexure- 1 the tender will be liable to be rejected.** Any overwriting or erasing in the figure shall not be considered for acceptance of the rates offered by the bidder. If the bidder do not fill the quotes or it is incomplete in the respective columns of **Annexure 1** the tender is liable to be rejected.
6. **The financial offer of lowest rates will be considered.** The bidder must note that the basis of evaluation of tenders of financial bids/offers would be based on the following:
The bidder must quote lump sum amount for all items in Annexure-1 and lowest offer (excluding goods and services tax) on the total amount (Indicated at A) will be considered as L1 offer. The rates of GST will be communicated to the successful bidder in their work order on the basic price.
7. The bidder must note that work shall be awarded to the lowest evaluated bidder whose bid has been found to be responsive and who is eligible and qualified to perform the contract satisfactory as per the terms and conditions incorporated in the corresponding bidding document.
8. **Hazardous chemical disposed to the bidder shall not be taken back by TMC-ACTREC under any circumstances.**
9. **The bidder has to make his own arrangements for collection, transportation & disposal of hazardous chemicals. Proper gate pass will be provided by ACTREC.**
10. In case if bidder fails to remove and lift the hazardous chemicals within the time limit centre will take strict action or penalty.
11. Centre will not be responsible in any manner for items which have been declared for disposal by the Institute and in case they are reused by the bidder, he will be responsible for all the consequential effects if any, bidder is advised not to try to reuse any of the items in any way.
12. No unauthorized person will be allowed to lift out material.
13. No subletting is allowed. Any tax liabilities will be on contractor's part and the centre will not be responsible in any manner.
14. Final decision as may be taken by the Director of the Institute in case of dispute, if any between the contractor and the disposing officer shall be analysed by him/her and his order will be binding on both the parties.

15. Rules of conduct will be observed by contractor's workers while collecting the hazardous chemicals.
16. Quotation in sealed envelopes marked as Inviting Annual Rate Contract for disposal of Hazardous chemical waste from various laboratories on 'As is where is basis' from ACTREC Kharghar. Along with the tender notice no. ACTREC/Admin/Chemical Disposal/2021-22 should be addressed to the Sr. Administrative Officer, 3rd floor, Advanced Centre for Treatment, Research and Education in Cancer, Sector-22, Kharghar, Navi Mumbai – 410210 and must be submitted by the due date and time in the room no.318, 3rd floor, PS building of the Institute.
17. Tenders received after the due date and time for any reason whatsoever shall not be considered and are liable to be rejected.
18. **Incomplete and unsigned quotations are liable to be rejected.**
19. **Each page of the tender should be signed /stamped by the bidder(s).**
20. It is **mandatory** for the bidder to provide self-attested copies of documents as given below for qualifying this tender.
 - a) **Address Proof (Voter -I card/ Aadhar card/ Electricity bill/ Telephone bill or any other documents etc.)**
 - b) **Income Tax PAN no.**
 - c) **GST (Goods and services Tax) registration number**
 - d) **The contractor should have valid authorization from Maharashtra Pollution Control Board (MPCB).**
 - e) **3 years' work experience require similar works.**
21. **Frequency for collection of waste from ACTREC may be quarterly by default. But contract may also specify that more or less visits may be requested depending the quantity of actual waste lot.**
22. **Payment will be settled within 30 days from the date of submission of the bill along with the supporting documents after due verification of the completion of work by NEFT/RTGS.**
23. It is also certified that this agency is not black listed by any government department nor any criminal case is registered/pending against the agency/firm/owner/ partner anywhere in India.
24. The centre reserves the right to accept or reject any/all tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever.
25. The bidder shall meet all the rules and regulation as stipulated by the MPCB
26. The bidder alone liable for any violation of laws and rules made there under, after collection of chemical from generator.
27. The bidder shall collection the chemical waste from identified collection point within the premises on monthly/quarterly/annual basis as and when required.
28. The bidder shall transport the chemical waste in the way guided by MPCB.
29. The bidder shall be responsible for the disposal chemical waste in the manner stated in MPCB guidelines.
30. The bidder shall liable to provide certificate after collection, transportation and disposal of Hazardous Chemical to ACTREC.

31. The bidder would also comply with all the Labour Laws as well as follows all statutory Norms for carrying out the above work.
32. Department from bidding: A bidder shall be debarred if he has been convicted of an offence under the prevention of corruption Act 1988 or the Indian Penal Code or any other law for the time being in force for causing any loss of life or property or causing a threat to public health as part execution of a public procurement contract.
33. A bidder debarred under clause no.32 or any successor of the bidder shall not participate in a tendering process of this centre for a period not exceeding three years commencing from the date of debarment.
34. The centre may debar a bidder or any of its successors from participating in any Tendering process undertaken by the Centre, for a period not exceeding two years, if it determines that the bidders has breached the code of integrity.
35. If a firm/bidder quotes nil charge/considerations the bid shall be treated as unresponsive and not be considered.
36. The resultant contract will be interpreted under Indian Laws.
37. In the event of any disputes arising out or in connection with this contract where during subsistence of the contract or thereafter the matter shall be referred to Director, TMC or any other officer nominated by the Director TMC for arbitration, whose decision shall be final and binding on the parties. The contractor should agree that the arbitrator could be an employee of the centre and shall not have any objection in this regards. The proceeding before the arbitrator could be governed by the provision of the Indian Arbitration Act 1996 and amendment thereof. The place of such arbitration should be Mumbai or Navi Mumbai and cost of such arbitration will be equally shared by the both parties.
