<u>WALK – IN – INTERVIEW FOR</u> ADVANCED TRAINING COURSE IN HISTOPATHOLOGY AND BASIC CYTOLOGY (2023)

Tata Memorial Centre, ACTREC announces "Advanced Training Course in Histopathology and Basic Cytology". This training program will be focused on histopathology and cytopathology, including frozen section cutting, special stains and immunohistochemistry. Additional emphasis on quality management with emphasis on accreditation related activity. The course will cover predominantly technical and practical aspects with related theoretical aspects and the most important aspect would be hands on training on state of the art equipments with emphasis on quality control. Selected candidates will be rotated through all the sections of the laboratory as per schedule. Certificates will be awarded to successful candidates on completion of the course.

2	AGE LIMIT	Upto 40 years as on 01.08.2023 (relaxable for sponsored candidates and SC / ST & OBC as per rules)
3	NO. OF SEATS	2 (Two)
4	SECURITY DEPOSIT	Selected candidates are required to deposit an amount of Rs. 10,000/ -(Rupees Ten Thousand only) at the time of joining. The deposit will be refunded without interest on completion of the training course or internship whichever is later. If the trainee leaves the training at any time before completion of the training, the deposit will stand forfeited.
5	STIPEND	Non-sponsored Candidates: Rs. 8,000/-per month (Rupees Eight Thousand Only) for six months. Sponsored Candidates: No Stipend.
6	SERVICE BOND	Non sponsored Candidates will be required to execute an agreement to serve the Tata Memorial Centre on a consolidated remuneration of Rs. 12,000/- per month. (Rupees Twelve Thousand only) for a period of six months, after successful completion of the training. No Bond is required for Sponsored Candidates.

(iii)	STRUCTURE OF THE COURSE	Rotation in various work areas will be approximately as follows: • Induction, orientation, sample collection and laboratory quality management • Routine Histotechniques (including Grossing, Processing, Embedding, Staining, Special stains • Frozen section • Immunohistochemistry • Cytology section • Periodic presentations in the laboratory about the various laboratory processes.
(iv)	OBJECTIVES	 At the end of the course, the student shall be able to: a) Work as technologist in accredited histopathology laboratories attached to hospitals under the supervision of seniors. They may be employed in a small laboratory functioning independently. b) Carry out advanced tests and techniques in Histopathology and cytology laboratories personally with effective quality control and provide patients with reliable reports. c) Acquire theoretical knowledge and practical skills leading to further specialization in the field. d) After successfully completion of course Certificate will Awarded to eligible Student

Outstation candidates may be provided accommodation (subject to availability) during the training period. They will have to pay accommodation charges as per institute policy.

Terms & Conditions:

- 1. During the period of training, the trainee shall not apply for any post or any other course / PG studies / scholarship or appear for any examination or interview outside without the permission of the Centre.
- 2. Any trainee leaving or remaining absent from the training before completion of this course will have to refund the amount of stipend together with interest thereon as per the rates fixed by the Centre. Candidates whose performance in the coursework is consistently found below expected standards will be terminated from the training course.
- 3. After six months training, the candidate has to fulfill the 'bond' by working for next six months in the Histopathology Lab, ACTREC. If the candidate leaves in between or breaks the bond, he/she will have to refund the full payment received. The decision of the Centre will be legal and binding in this respect.
- 4. If more than 30 candidates apply for the positions, a written examination will be conducted, and the short listed candidates will be interviewed. Candidates will be selected based on their performance in the interview.
- 5. Persons working under Central/ State Government, Autonomous Body, Semi Government Organizations and other Public Sector Undertakings must submit No Objection Certificate from their present employer.
- 6. TMC, ACTREC reserves the right to restrict the number of candidates for the interview to a reasonable limit on the basis of qualification and marks. Merely fulfilling the prescribed qualifications will not entitle an applicant for the interview. TMC, ACTREC also reserves the right to reject any of the applications without assigning any reason thereof.
