A school teacher, pernicious anemia, poultry farming, mice breeding

In her small white farmhouse in Granby, Massachusetts, bred a varlety of small animals: ferrets, rabbits, guinea pigs, rats, and, most notably, mice.

In 1902, her mice became the first to be used in a lab for genetic research—which continues till today.







